On December 13, 2018, the Presiding Officer submitted her Recommended Order of Dismissal on Respondent’s Motion to Dismiss (“Order”) to the State Board of Administration (“SBA”) in this proceeding. 
ORDERED

The Notice of Appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days from the date the Final Order is filed with the Clerk of the State Board of Administration.






